AWARD

CRITERIA

- ◆ The scholarship will be awarded to a student with the academic standing of a junior who is pursuing a teaching certificate.
- ◆ The applicant must attend a publicly supported, four-year Alabama college or university.
- ◆ The recipient of the scholarship agrees to teach in Alabama for at least one year following graduation.

APPLICATION

- ◆ All Schools of Education at publicly supported, four-year Alabama colleges and universities will be advised of this scholarship.
- ◆ The application must be accompanied by two letters of recommendation, one of which shall be from a person in the field of education.
