A professor of pediatrics at UAB, Dr. Simpson practices at the Adolescent Health Center at Children's of Alabama. She is actively involved with the Birmingham Mayor's Office Division of Youth Services with events such as "Take a Child to the Doctor Day," and has been recognized by the city as a "Hidden Hero." She has also received the Golden Physician Award from the Metro Birmingham Branch of the NAACP. She has been a recipient of the B-Metro Magazine's Top Doctors and Best Doctors in America awards.

Most recently, Dr. Simpson is leading a Maternal Child Health-funded adolescent wellness initiative, and is a content expert for the Alabama Child Health Improvement Alliance's #StayWell 2019 adolescent collaborative.
