Elizabeth Baldwin Hill Scholarship

Supported by Alabama PTA Scholarship Fund

Award

A one-time scholarship of \$500, paid to the recipient's college or university in the summer or fall semester immediately following grant award.

The scholarship recipient will be notified by mail and email and invited to attend the Alabama PTA Awards Banquet.

Criteria

- 1. The scholarship will be awarded to a student with the academic standing of a junior who is pursuing a teaching certificate.
- 2. Applicant must be a current member of a PTA/PTSA. (be prepared to show proof of membership)
- 3. The applicant must attend a publicly supported, four-year Alabama college or university.
- 4. The applicant will commit to teach in Alabama for at least a year.
- 5. Immediate family members of the Alabama PTA Board of Directors or staff are not eligible to apply.
- 6. A completed electronic application must be received by March 1. The application can be found <u>Here</u>

Application Process

- 2. A resume, limited to one page, listing school activities, community involvement, special recognitions and awards the applicant has received.
- 3. Copy of transcript (does not need to be "official"
- 4. Responses to the following questions will be required to be completed during the application process. Each response will have a minimum and maximum word count.
 - a. Describe your future goals for both your education and career. (200-250)
 - b. How has your family and/or a mentor impacted your education and encouraged your post-high school studies? (200-250)
 - c. Describe the role PTA has played in supporting and enriching your K-12 education (250-300)
 - d. List any work experience, including internships.
- 2. Two letters of recommendation, one of which shall be from a person in the field of education.

The application and supporting documents must be submitted electronically per instructions on scholarship application.
